Iain then confirmed that he had spoken to an electrician regarding extra power supply for the Centre and that he was merely waiting for a quote on how much it would cost - although the electrician had confirmed that he would be able to carry the work out at fairly short notice.

Iain confirmed that he had spoken again with Ian Dyer from Inverclyde Council regarding the graffiti and that the Council were arranging to have this cleaned.
