Welcome

Kirsty Donnelly in the chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked everyone for attending. The Minutes of the last meeting were proposed by Anne-Marie Cockburn and seconded by Iain Buchan.

Treasurer's Report

Up-to-date financial information was in the process of being passed from our old Treasurer to our new Treasurer and an update would be given at the next meeting.

Letting Secretary's Report

Kirsty confirmed that parties were continuing to come in.
